

The Art of Writing Reasons (Webinar) – Answers to Assignment (Slide 37)

1. Laurence Olivier and Vivien Leigh are not spouses.
2. In the first incident Laurence Olivier allegedly directed Ms. Russell not to call the police. He did not refuse to call the police.
3. Ms. Russell's name is misspelled.
4. While not an error, per se, the kick in the behind was not described as an "assault" by anyone. That is the committee's choice of words.
5. In the second incident Laurence Olivier did intervene.
6. In the second incident there was a dispute about terminating the relationship with the client, but Vivien Leigh did not do it. Laurence Olivier eventually "discontinued service" to the client.
7. Again, while not an error, the term "terminated the client" is the committee's own characterization of what happened, not what the witness called it.
